Dear colleagues,

The Mathematical Society of South-Eastern Europe is organizing the 10th Mathematical Olympiad for first and second year university students, **SEEMOUS 2016**. This well established university student competition will be hosted by the Cyprus Mathematical Society between 1-6 March in the beautiful beach resort area of Protaras, Cyprus. We kindly invite you to participate in SEEMOUS 2016 with a team from your university. The aim of this competition is to challenge and encourage mathematically gifted university students for further development in Mathematics, to help them communicate and cooperate with other students and possibly future colleagues as Mathematicians, to create a friendly relationship and cooperation between our mathematical societies and university mathematics departments.

Regulations. A team may consist of up to 6 students and 2 professors (a team leader and a deputy team leader). Eligible students are those who are not beyond the second university year of undergraduate studies by the end of the 2015/2016 academic year or have not completed more than 120 ETCS credits until 1 March, 2016. Students may participate as a University Team or a National Team or both. The deadline for submitting the registration form of participation is 1 February 2016.

Problem proposals. Each team can send up to three problem proposals until 1 February, 2016. Problem proposals must be written in English in MS Word document (doc or docx), with Times New Roman font, formulas in Equation or Math Type 6+. PDF file of the document must be sent as well to cms@cms.org.cy.

Participation fee information. All SEEMOUS2016 participants will have to cover their own travel, accommodation and subsistence expenses. A participation fee is pre-paid to the Cyprus Mathematical Society (CMS) in the amount of 320 EUR per person. It covers: accommodation (full board) for five nights in a double or triple bed room in "Constantinos the Great" Beach Hotel by TSOKKOS hotels (5 stars - <http://www.tsokkos.com>, 29 Protaras Avenue, Protaras, Paralimni 5296, Cyprus) in the Protaras Beach Resort, farewell dinner, excursion-social event and working materials. Please specify (in the registration form) in what kind of room (triple bed, double bed or single bed) you want to be placed in. Please note that accommodation in a single bed room costs

460 EUR per person, (full board) for five nights. All students will be accommodated in triple bed rooms and depending on gender constraints in double room without extra cost. All professors will be accommodated in double rooms except if they wish to stay in single room and pay the additional cost.
