Junior Balkan Mathematical Olympiad 2019

20 – 25 June 2019, Cyprus

Cyprus is hosting the 23rd Balkan Mathematical Olympiad for students under the age of 15.5 , which will be held on 20-25 June 2019. The event is organized by the Cypriot Mathematical Society and is hosted under the auspices of the Ministry of Education and Culture of Cyprus. The Olympiad involves member countries as well as guest countries. The member countries are the members of the Mathematical Society of South-Eastern Europe (MASSEE) with register office in Athens, Greece. The JBMO is a similar Olympiad as BMO with BMO for students upto the upper secondary education, which is organized usually in the beginning of May.

The purpose of Balkan Math Olympiads are to develop stronger bonds between the nations of the South-Eastern Europe , develop exchange of ideas in the subject of Mathematics and support talented students in the topic by giving them an opportunity to express and develop their talent in Mathematics. At the same time the member countries and the guest countries promote the learning of Mathematics and provide the ground for the development of future Mathematicians who can contribute to creativity, research, innovation and certainly new Mathematics.

In 2019, the participating member countries are Cyprus, Greece, Romania, Bulgaria, North Macedonia, Moldova, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Serbia. The guest countries include Croatia, Azerbaijan, Ecuador, France, Kazakhstan, Saudi Arabia.

The main program of the Olympiad is as follows:

The Opening Ceremony , hosted by the Mayor and Municipality of Limassol is organized on 21 June 2019 at the Panos Solomonidis Cultural Center in Limassol.

The problem selection will be completed by the Jury on 21st June at the Forest Park hotel in Platres.

The Competition will take place on 22 June, 9.30 - 14.00, at the Rodon Hotel in Agros. The marking and final Jury meeting to decide on awards will be completed on 23 June. At The JBMO 2019 Award Ceremony will be organized at 19.00 on 24 June at the Rodon Hotel in Agros.
